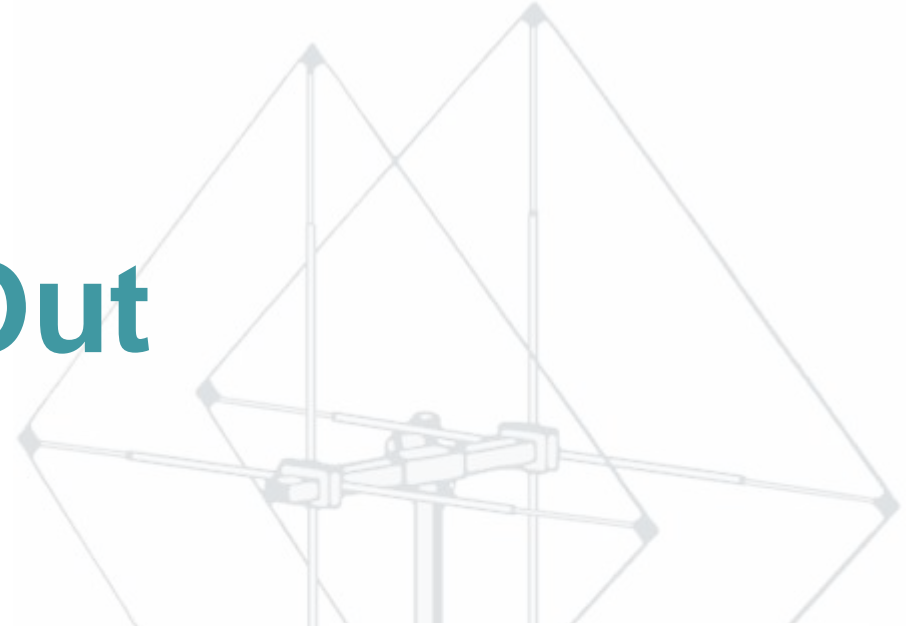

The Great California **SHAKE OUT**

Coastside CERT Area-Wide Exercise

October 10<sup>th</sup> 10:00am -12:00pm (noon)

# Scenario

10:15 October 10:

- California is struck by an earthquake.
- Some areas have extensive damage to infrastructure while other areas only experienced minor damage.
- Gas lines, power lines, cell, radio, TV towers are severely damaged in some locations and may be out for weeks. Other areas are experiencing intermittent outages.
- Public services communications are down or severely overloaded.
- Travel may be hazardous because of fallen power lines, ruptured gas lines, damaged roads, and damaged or fallen bridges.
- CERT/ARES Team need to report to designated meeting points and organize communications with the area DOC.
- Deployed operators must adhere to all COVID-19 safety precautions recommended by CDC.

# Objectives

- Practice activation protocols and go-bag kits.
- Establish a local neighborhood radio station to communicate with the DOC.
- Practice use of ICS forms even outside the DOC.
- Report local situation to the DOC
  - each meeting point will decide an insert for the DOC and receive and insert from the DOC.
- Exercise communication between DOCs

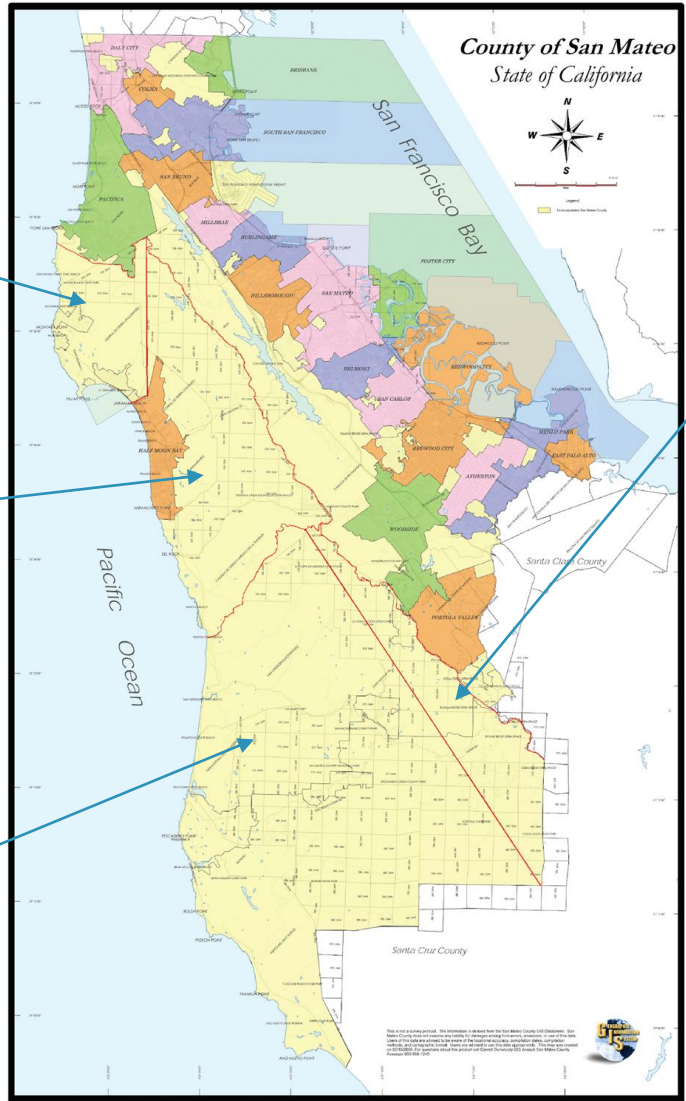

- People at each meeting expect to receive a challenge from the DOC and act consequently
- People at each meeting point should also come up with a challenge for the DOC.
